

MANDATORY & ENFORCEABLE CODES OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES, PLAYERS, PARENTS, SUPPORTERS AND OFFICIALS

Fakenham Basketball Club fully supports the codes of conduct.

COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

Coaches are required to sign the Fakenham Basketball Club Code of Conduct as part of the requirement to coach for the club. All coaches must be accredited to coach in our league with the relevant qualifications in order to coach legally.

- Play by the rules – the rules of your club and the laws of the game.
- Never argue with an umpire or other official – without these people, you can't play.
- Control your temper - verbal abuse towards officials, other coaches and other players will not be tolerated.
- Be a team player – it's a team sport, treat it that way.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated – fairly.
- Any prejudice remarks will not be tolerated.

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

A Parent or Guardian of a Player, aged under 18 years old, is required to sign the Fakenham Basketball Club Code of Conduct as part of the requirement for their child to become a member.

- Play by the rules – the rules of your club and the laws of the game.
- Never argue with an umpire or other official – without these people, you can't play.
- Control your temper - verbal abuse towards officials and other players will not be tolerated.
- Be a team player – it's a team sport, treat it that way.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated – fairly.
- Co-operate with your coach, the umpires and team-mates.
- Play for your own enjoyment & to improve your skills.
- Any prejudice remarks will not be tolerated.

PARENTS & SUPPORTERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Any Parent or Guardian of a Player is required to sign the Fakenham Basketball Club Code of Conduct as part of the requirement to participate in spectating, events and other any other involvement with the club.

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not downgrade.

- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires – raise personal concerns with club officials in private and in an appropriate manner.
- Any prejudice remarks will not be tolerated.

By registering our child with the Fakenham Basketball Club we agree to abide by these principles.

We support the Club in it's undertakings and encourage the Club to take any necessary disciplinary actions including the suspension and banning where warranted of any players, parents and or spectators for repeated or serious breaches of these Codes of Conduct.
